Art Resident Teacher

This is a rich opportunity for someone interested in becoming a teacher to gain experience while working with expert teachers. You will also participate in the greater community of the school including substituting in classes across the curriculum, taking part in the advisory program, teaching elective and intersession courses, chaperoning field trips (day and overnight), and participating in faculty meetings and professional development.

- Experience working with students in some capacity (teaching, tutoring, coaching, camp...)
- Enthusiasm for pursuing a teaching career

- Desire to learn about and experiment with progressive teaching methods
- Excitement to support middle school students in the arts
